

DIY Animal Pen Pot Holder

You will need:

- 1 x Template printed onto card
- PVA White Glu
- Glu Dots
- Blue Glu Stick

- Yoghurt bottles
- Scissors
- Embellishments
- Coloured card
- 1. Print out these instructions and selected animal character/s. Either print out your templates on white card to colour in or print on coloured card.
- 2. Once printed, cut out each individual shape of your animal character with scissors.



Tacky's tip:

Children should have adult supervision when cutting with scissors.

- 3. When each shape has been cut out, the decoration can start! Starting with the front section of your animal character, colour in, paint and glue on a range of embellishments with PVA white Glu or a Blu Glu stick.
- 4. Once you've decorated the base of your animal character, glue down the facial features with a Blu Glu stick.
- 5. Glue on the eyes provided on the PDF and add googly eyes if desired.
- 6. Attach three Glu Dots to one side of your yoghurt bottle and peel off the backing.
- 7. Secure the back of the front piece of card to the yoghurt bottle. The yoghurt bottle should be positioned in the centre of the card with the hole at the top.
- 8. Pick up the back piece of card for your animal character and attach one or two Glu Dots to the sides as desired. Peel off the backing.
- 9. Attach the back piece of card to the front card so the yoghurt bottle is in the middle. Attach any final embellishments including the tail to the back card using a Blu Glu stick.
- **10.** And there you have it your yoghurt bottle animal is completed! Add in pencils or pens to the yoghurt bottle for an easy DIY pen pot holder!
